

Scholarship for participation in the ECPR Summer School in Methods and Techniques (Ljubljana) 24 July - 9 August 2014

The European Consortium for Political Research ([ECPR](#)) regularly organizes summer schools for PhD candidates in political science. The “ECPR Summer School in Methods and Techniques” planned on 24 July - 9 August 2014 in Ljubljana provides high quality up-to-date training in a broad range of specially selected methods across the whole spectrum of approaches employed within the social sciences.

In line with its main objective to support promising young researchers from the South Caucasus, ASCN offers 4 PhD students in social sciences from Universities in Georgia and Armenia the opportunity to participate in this 2-week Summer School.

Courses and Modules

Scholars must choose one module from the courses B01 to B11 or 2 modules from C01 to C12 and D01 to D10 as described on the course list of the summer school website (<http://www.ecpr.eu/Events/PanelList.aspx?EventID=92>). Participation in a 3-day refresher course (A01-A05) may also be covered by ASCN and is strongly encouraged. Eligibility criteria

- PhD candidates in social sciences (political science or sociology) from any university in Georgia or Armenia
- Citizens of Armenia or Georgia normally residing in Armenia or Georgia
- strong skills in research methodology
- excellent knowledge of English

Candidates with potential to transfer the acquired knowledge further within their institution (through teaching) will be given priority.

Documents to submit

- motivation letter (including, among other things, experience and skills in research methodology)
- CV
- Short description of the PhD project (2 pages maximum)
- short description of the methodology applied in your PhD project
- indication of the module(s) you intend to register for and relevance for your own research
- copy of passport

Scholarship

The grant covers the following aspects:

- summer school fee
- travel costs
- accommodation
- daily allowances

Deadlines

Please merge all the requested documents into one single pdf file and submit the application to info@ascn.ch **until 20 April 2014 with the following subject line: ECPR Summer School / ASCN**. Applications submitted after 20 April 2014 will not be taken into consideration.

Selection

The selection will be made by the ASCN Local Coordination Units in Georgia and Armenia, together with the ASCN programme management in Fribourg (Switzerland).

Please note that ASCN cannot guarantee the acceptance of the selected candidates in the summer school. This is the full responsibility of ECPR. Candidates selected by ASCN will have to register for the summer school on their own.
