



## EMBASSY OF THE REPUBLIC OF BULGARIA IN GEORGIA

1. The Jean Monnet Center of European Politics in the New Bulgarian University (NBU) is an educational institution in Bulgaria created in October 2006 which was authorized by the EC to teach Master programs in European Governance for the academic year 2010-2011. The centre has announced its admissions from partner-countries and Russia under the auspices of the European Neighborhood Policy (ENP).
  2. The selection of the candidates will be conducted by the EC. The candidates will be contacted on individual basis and therefore their personal contact details and data will be needed.
  3. The courses under the Programme will take place in the Jean Monnet Center of European Politics. Direct exchanges with other European educational institutions in EU member-states are also envisaged with this exchanges in fact being part of the Programme.
  4. The duration of the courses under the Programme is two academic years.
  5. The tuition fees, subsistence, accommodation costs, as well as travel expenses and expenses covering the needed books and services throughout the studies will be covered by the NBU in conjunction with the financial requirements of the EC.
  6. The applicants should correspond to the following requirements:
    - 6.1. They should hold BA or MA in their country of origin in one of the following fields: Law, Economics, Social Sciences, Administration, History, and Political Science. They should certify this by presenting a translated and legalized document in English which should be sent to NBU not later than 24 May, 2010.
    - 6.2. They should have command of English or French languages, or at least have oral skills in one of the languages. If needed, they can use Russian language to communicate with the lecturers.
    - 6.3. They should fill in and send the European CV format as per the template attached not later than 24 May, 2010.
    - 6.4. They should send an essay in English or French languages up to 2 typewriter pages in which they should describe their motivation to study courses on European affairs, how they deem to employ the acquired competences and knowledge and how these will help them for their professional development.
- The Diploma which will be awarded upon successful graduation of the Programme and the examinations marks are recognized in the whole EU area.
