Overview

- The master's programme is divided into two study tracks.

Study track A

- Integrated study abroad during the first semester
- Mandatory for applicants who have not previously studied outside of Germany
- Recommendation: Rijksuniversiteit Groningen (RUG), the Netherlands
- Additional LL.M. in Law in Europe awarded by the RUG
- No separate application is necessary, but additional tuition fees have to be paid at RUG.¹ Reimbursement is partly possible.

Study track B

- The whole programme takes place in Bremen and Oldenburg
- Strong focus on the transnationalization of private and public law during the first semester
- Flexibility through compulsory elective modules
- One LL.M. awarded by the universities of Bremen and Oldenburg

Admission requirements

- Prior academic degree equivalent to at least 240 CP (4 study years) in a legal or comparable subject
- B2-level English language proficiency¹
- B2-level German language proficiency¹
- Letter of Motivation (max. 2000 words)
