Course description

- 1. academic through scholarly seminars
- 2. competencies through theme-based workshops
- 3. practice through project-based workshops.

Seminars themes:

International cooperation: Current issues and strategies; international project management; contemporary influence of intercultural relations on the media; contemporary international economic issues; culture and globalization, integrating cultural diversity in European management.

Workshops themes:

International project management; intercultural negotiation; legal aspects of international cooperation; intercultural communication; integrating cultural diversity in European management; communicating with body language.

Themes discussed in these seminars and workshops will be illustrated by case studies from Europe, the Middle East and the Americas.

Rich and varied cultural activities will allow students to discover the region of the Yvelines and give them a more relaxed environment to experience this intercultural exchange program.
