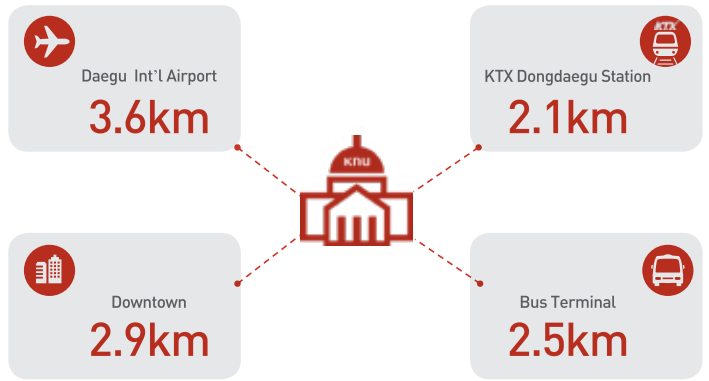

3. Important Notes

- ① Screening is based on the applicant's transcripts, personal statement, study plan, recommendation letters, language proficiency(Korean and English), published papers, and department interview.
- ② Applicants who have the Korean language proficiency certificate(TOPIK) or English proficiency certificate(TOEFL, IELTS) will get advantages.
- ③ Applicants should choose only one track among University or Embassy. Dual application is not permitted.
- ④ Incomplete or incorrect documents and **just copied documents** are subject to rejection by KNU & NIIED.
- ⑤ For Department of Medicine and Department of Dentistry, only those who have degrees or medical doctor's/dentist's license in the majors can apply.
- ⑥ After passing the screenings at KNU, it is not possible to change the major or department.
- ⑦ Applicants for Department of Fine Art and Department of Design should submit free-form portfolio.

- ① Dormitory Fee : Approximately 300,000Won/Month
- ② All KGSP scholars will be given a chance to live in the dormitory.

History

- ① 1946. Colleges of Education, Medicine and Agriculture in Daegu upgraded to National College.
- ② 1951. Colleges of Education, Medicine, Agriculture, Liberal Arts and Sciences, Law and Political Sciences were combined to create Kyungpook National University.
- ③ 1953. First Graduate School was established.
- ④ 2020. KNU is comprised of 19 Colleges, 68 majors, 26 schools, 12 graduate schools

Location

- ① KNU is located in the city of Daegu, the third largest city in South Korea with a population of approximately 2.5 milion.
- ② Less than 2 hours from Seoul by express train, Daegu combines the best of modern and traditional Korea, being surrounded by major industries, such as Samsung and LG, and UNESCO world heritage sites of Gyeongju and Haeinsa temple.
- ③ Three presidents of Korea were born in this region, one of them is a KNU graduate.

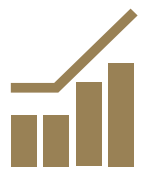

GLOBAL KOREA SCHOLARSHIP (GKS-KGSP) Graduate Program



1. Purpose

- To provide international students with an opportunity to conduct advanced studies at higher educational institutions in Korea
- To support the future global leaders and promote the international cooperation in education

2. Qualifications

	1. The applicant and his/her parents must hold foreign citizenships. * Applicants who hold Korean citizenship are not permitted to apply for this program.	
Qualifications	2. Applicants must be under 40 years of age as of Sep. 1st, 2020 (born after Sep. 1st, 1980).	
	3. Applicants must hold a Bachelor's, Master's, or Doctoral degree as of September 1st of the selection year. * Applicants who have completed degree program in Korea are not eligible for the program. But those who have graduated from degree program in Korea through KGSP can apply for this program.	
	4. The academic achievement of the applicants must meet one of the followings: The grade point average (GPA) must be no less than 2.64 on a 4.0 scale, 2.80 on a 4.3 scale, 2.91 on a 4.5 scale, or 3.23 on a 5.0 scale, -The overall grades must be no less than 80% out of 100%.	

3. Selection Procedure

- 1st Selection** : Applicants submit their applications either to the Korean Embassies around the world or to the partering universities in Korea. The embassies and universities select the successful candidates among the applicants in the 1st round of selection. The applicants of the successful candidates will then be forwarded to NIIED.
- 2nd Selection** : The NIIED selection committee selects the successful candidates among those who passed the 1st round.
- 3rd Selection** : Among the successful candidates who have passed the 2nd round, the applicants of those who applied through the Korean Embassies will be reviewed by universities for admission. Successful candidates must get admission from at least one of the universities.

- Required documents : one set of original(or notarized) documents.
- Original documents should be submitted. However, in case of submitting copied documents inevitably, applicants must submit the notarized or apostilled copies of the original version. (※ Submitted documents will not be returned to the candidates.)
- Applicants who are expected to graduate from their institutions by August 31st, 2020 first must submit the certificate of expectant graduation issued by their attended institution.
- If the transcript is not indicated in grade point average(GPA), attachment of transcript converted into 4.0, 4.3, 4.5, or 5.0 scale is required. (KNU accepts the result issued from <http://www.scholaro.com>, but it should be verified by the previously attended university)
- If grades or marks in the transcript are not suitable to CGPA and Score Percentile format, applicants can additionally submit rank-certificate from their attended university.
- Documents not in English or Korean must be accompanied by a complete and accurate English or Korean translation certified by the issuing institution.
- Each required document must be numbered and labeled on the top right corner. (Example: [9.Bachelor's Degree Certificate])
- Bind the documents only with clips or binder clips (**Do not use stapler**).
- Please paste a photograph to the application form (**Do not use stapler**).
