

Call for papers

CARIM-East coordinating team invites proposals to author a paper on:

DEVELOPMENT AND SIDE EFFECTS OF REMITTANCES IN GEORGIA

The paper should discuss the broad range of impacts of remittances on the countries of origin, but most importantly:

- Literature review (specific for the country)
- Statistical data on remittances available in Georgia
- Remittances and growth
- Remittances, investment and financial development
- Remittances and employment
- Remittances and inflation
- Remittances and human capital formation
- Remittances, poverty and income inequality
- Remittances, public moral hazard, informalised welfare and policy trap.

The expected length of the paper should be around 30-35 pages single space, tables and graphs included. The paper should have an executive summary. The deadline for the first draft is 1 September 2012. The author will be remunerated 2500 EUR.

The paper will be published as a research paper on the CARIM-East website. The ultimate goal is to produce a volume on the flow and impact of remittances to, from and within the CARIM region. The volume will be peer reviewed and contributors are expected to comply with normal requirements for scholarly publications.

- Up to 1500 word abstract that includes a short discussion of sources and methodology.
- 2. 2-page CV that includes a list of relevant publications
