Certification of American Chemical Society (ACS) is underway, which is a highly reputable and one of the oldest professional unions.

Educational program is created with consideration of all theoretical and practical courses that are necessary to obtain relevant qualification. Teaching chemical and biochemical labs are equipped with cutting edge chemical equipment, where students will gain practical skills and experience to work in modern laboratory.

The program also contains diverse general education subjects and is targeted to Georgian and foreign students.

- 2. English Language (minimal competence level 60%)
- 3. Mathematics

For foreign citizens:

- 1. In accordance with Georgian legislation;
- 2. One of the following valid English language certificates: Cambridge English First Certificate (Band C,B,A), IELTS (Band 5,5 and more), TOEFL (Internet based- 65 and more; TOEFL (Paper -based- 513 and more) or English Language B2 level admission exam at TSU.

- 2. 10,000 GEL for Foreign students
