


Course Title: Prehistoric Archaeology from the Paleolithic to the Metal Ages: Methods and Perspectives.

Course Description: The course is divided into lectures regarding the origin of prehistoric archaeology in Europe and the Middle East, the terminology employed by the investigators, the methods of absolute and relative chronology, the different periods into which it is subdivided from the Paleolithic to the the Chalcolithic, the processes of Anthropisation, the diffusion models of the different hominid species (H.Habilis, H. Erectus, H. Neanderthaleneses, H. Sapiens or modern humans), the last hunter-gatherers of the Early Holocene, the Neolithisation processes which led to the domestication of plants and animals, and food production in the Levant. The courses are delimited by the beginning of the Metal Ages.


